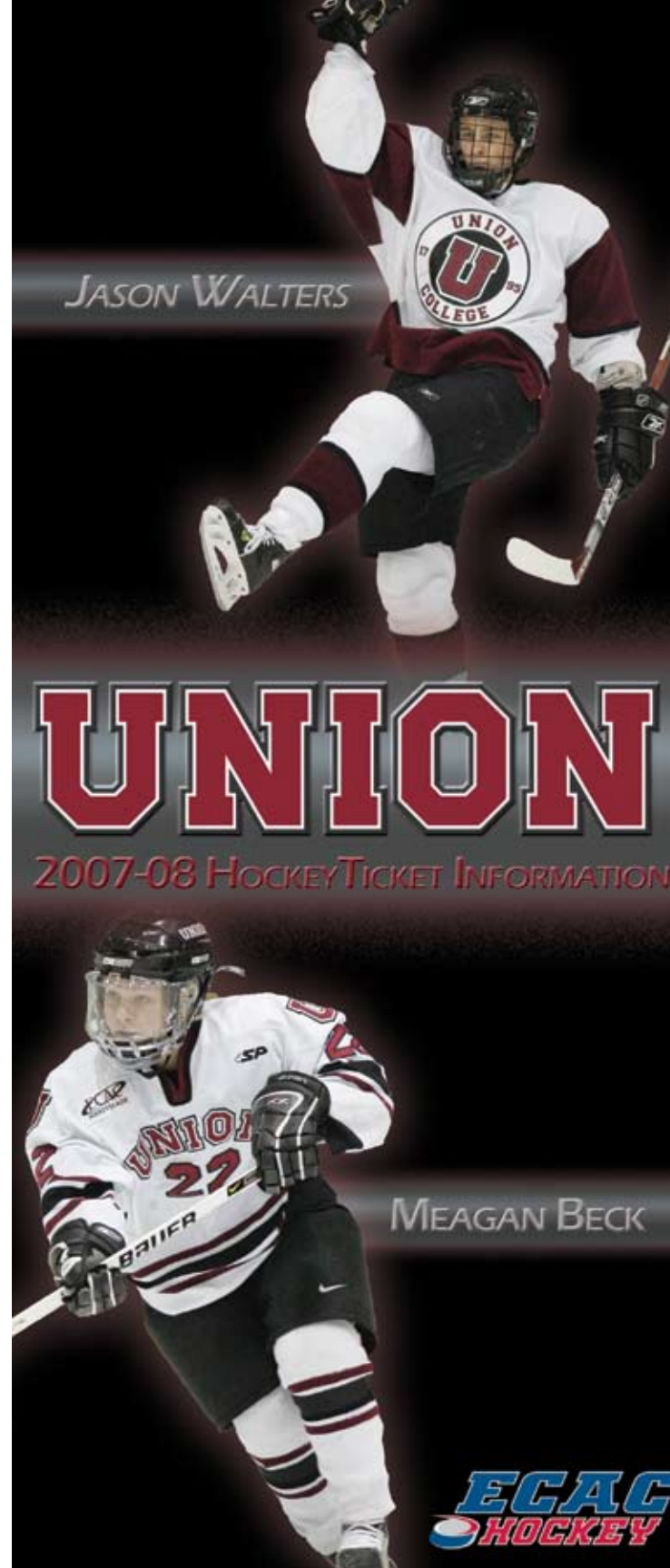

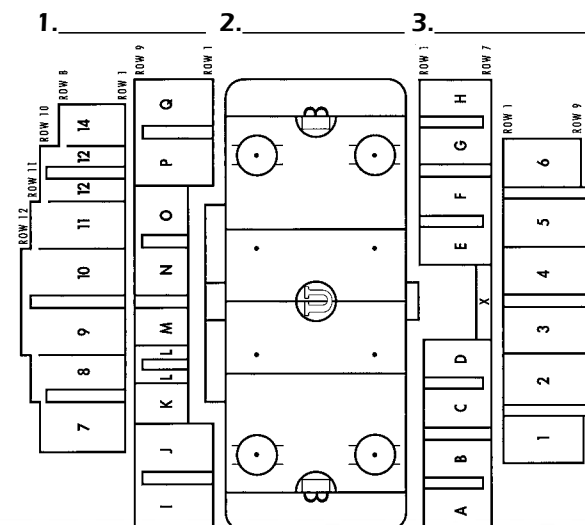

First Year Head Coach Claudia Asano



Asano was named Head Women's Ice Hockey Coach in April, 2007. An assistant coach at Harvard University for the past five seasons, Asano took the helm of the women's hockey program in early May.

As the top assistant to Head Coach Katey Stone, Asano worked with the Crimson's defense, led Harvard's recruiting efforts and helped lead the Crimson to the NCAA Frozen Four finals from 2003-05, three ECACHL tournament championships from 2004-06, three Beanpot championships and two Ivy League titles.

A 1999 graduate of Harvard University, Asano was a three-year letter-winner for the women's hockey team. She captained the 1999 squad to the ECACHL regular-season and tournament championships and the American Women's College Hockey Alliance Division I title.
